JESUS IS ALIVE - DON ROSENKJAR

Luke 24: 1-12

Very early on Sunday morning, the women went to the tomb, carrying the spices that they had prepared. 2 When they found the stone rolled away from the entrance, 3 they went in. But they did not find the body of the Lord Jesus, 4 and they did not know what to think.

Suddenly two men in shining white clothes stood beside them. 5 The women were afraid and bowed to the ground. But the men said, "Why are you looking in the place of the dead for someone who is alive? 6 Jesus isn't here! He has been raised from death".

nonsense, and they would not believe. 12 But Peter ran to the tomb. And when he stooped down and looked in, he saw only the burial clothes. Then he returned, wondering what had happened.

This Easter is something really special for all of us who believe in Jesus Christ's Resurrection. The pandemic is pretty much behind us, and most of us can go to churches to celebrate, with much joy. For me, I often wondered about this: here in Southern California, Easter Sunday is always, always sunny and warm. Sometimes, on Saturday, just a day before Easter, we

would have rain. Then, on Monday, a day after Easter, it can be cloudy and chilly. Maybe it's just my imagination, but my point is this: Easter is an amazing day, a truly awesome celebration that Jesus Christ has gotten out of the tomb alive, and greeted Mary Magdalene. Imagine how Mary Magdalene felt when she realized Jesus was alive!

Why should we be so thrilled about this? Well, He gives us hope, a factual hope that we too will live after we die. We too will go to an exciting place called

Heaven. There's one interesting thought that I want to mention: since most of us are Deaf, and when we go to Heaven, no one will need a hearing aid. (I'll leave mine at home when I die) because we'll be able to talk with loved ones who were not deaf with so much ease. No interpreters are needed. No lip reading is needed. So, my dear friends, celebrate Easter!



"Remember that while he was still in Galilee, he told you, 7 'The Son of Man will be handed over to sinners who will nail him to a cross. But three days later he will rise to life". 8 Then they remembered what Jesus had said.

OFF THE GRID MISSIONS

DEAF HELPING DEAF UKRANIANS

Since the war in Ukraine began, we have been developing unique disaster-focused strategies for Deaf people both in Ukraine and on the frontlines of the surrounding borders of Ukraine. We have been funding DIRECTLY to deaf frontline volunteers from drivers and navigators to support their resources such as gas, shelter, beds, food, train and bus tickets —all as it relates to the evacuations and influx of Deaf/Hh refugees. These funds directly cover the fleeing of Deaf/Hh individuals from Ukraine, and getting them to their next destination where they can safely settle amidst other countries beyond the border who are offering support specifically for Deaf/Hh refugees. The reason we remain focused on the frontlines is because the primary goal is to evacuate individuals from Ukraine and the way in which we are donating is unique to each operation—some we are funding the evacuations gas/food, all the way to building makeshift shelters. With every team/individual we are working with we are bridging NGO requests re: disaster-specific resources (infos/alerts/operations).

This update in particular is from one of those teams whom we are supporting, DeafBridge, a Deaf faith-based organization who immediately redirected their focus to work the frontlines at the Romania-Ukraine border.

Ukraine is in really bad condition, the situation is growing increasingly worse... this update is specific to Ukraine —> Romania at one of two checkpoints we are supporting in that region. Right now, the wave of refugees is low due to new threats and negotiations. What will happen next is out of our control and we are trying our best to use the resources we have in place to support those most vulnerable during this time.

Thank you to everyone who has been donating, amplifying, and fundraising. More to come.
