We had over 40 people who came and took advantage of the feast that was offered besides having dishes available for people to take home. The reason we did this was in November, you may recall, SNAP benefits were on hold at the time because of the government shutdown and PDC wanted to step in and fill this need as much as possible.

We also partnered with Greater Marion County Association for the Deaf (GMCAD), and Center of Independent Living (CIL) with the Appleton Museum in Ocala, where we had a community tree set up that represented the Deaf community. Plus, we had an ILY with sign language on the ornament to give out to the community who visit the ASL tree.

We can't wait to see what God is up to next. Have a blessed Christmas and New Year from Palms Deaf Church.



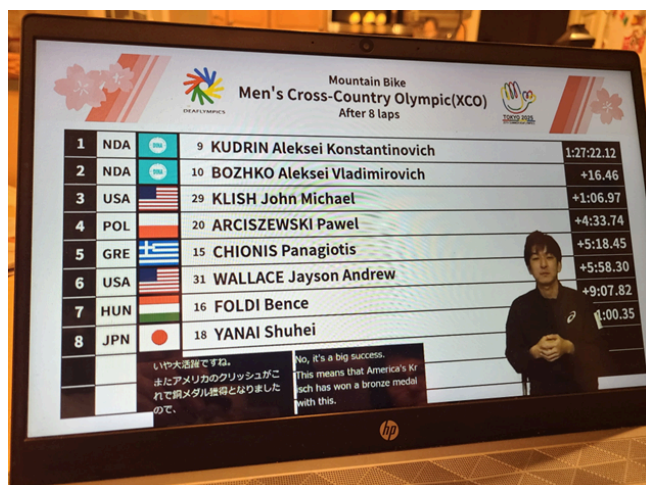
# MINISTRY REPORTS

## CHRIST THE KING

The day after DeafCAN!'s 15th Anniversary Open House, five CTK and an interpreter attended our Synod Cluster (Chester County) Gala on 11/9. Our Cluster was given \$5000 seed money and the churches had a buffet dinner, dance, and Silent Auction to benefit the war-torn areas of Palestine and Ukraine. International missionaries Bevan and Laura Stein were speakers. 130 people attended and we raised \$33,000 that evening. CTK donated ASL classes to the Silent Auction. This was \$100 a plate!



- In November, our local Thrivent office hosted an early showing of the movie, “Wicked: For Good,” and offered a buffet dinner at the theatre. 12 Deaf attended and Thrivent convinced the theatre to use open captions! This event was a food-raiser for our community food cupboard, so we raised \$1575 (cash and grocery cards) and 331 lb. of food.
- We had a private **Friendsgiving dinner** for our refugee/immigrant group and gathered to share our international potluck feast. It is a fearful time for many of them. Please keep them in prayer! We work with 38 countries.
- One of CTK members, **Jayson Wallace, went to Tokyo, Japan** to participate in the Deaflympics in cycling and mountain bike racing. See the picture page in this newsletter.
- **Jayson won first place (gold) in the sprint race.**
- He did not finish the Points Race.
- In the Individual Time Trial, he placed 36th.
- In the Individual Road Race (62 miles at a 9,600 foot elevation/height), he placed 5th.
- For Mountain Biking, he won 6th place for the Cross-Country Short Track.
- Last night, for the Cross-Country Olympic (14 miles), he placed 6th after having a flat tire in the last half of the last lap. He ran with his bike through the mountains to the finish line! 30 men were in that race and only eight finished.
- Jayson is a junior at King College in Tennessee. His parents are Connie and Stefan Wallace. Connie is also Office Manager for CTK/DeafCAN!

- Another CTK member, **Jason Marple**, who graduated from Gallaudet last December with a B.S. in Physical Ed and minor in Sports Management, was hired by PSD as a HS English teacher and **head coach for the boys' Varsity Basketball team**. He previously was assistant coach for two years at MSSD. Recently, his boys' team and the PSD girls' team both won the champion tipoff at Marie Katzenbach School for the Deaf (NJ), Division 2. The boys won 4th place and girls 3rd place at The Learning Center (MA) for Division 1. Jason is the son of Terri and Mark Marple. Terri is CTK Council president.

- In December, seven CTK women and our interpreter attended the **Christmas Tea hosted by our host congregation**, Calvary Lutheran. 160 women attended. Each table had a hostess and decorated their table in advance. Our table theme was "Holly Berries" and decorated by Gloria Weiler, Linda Sheak, and hostess Connie Wallace.

**CTK Christmas luncheon** had to be postponed 12/14 to 12/21 due to a snowstorm! We will have a Silent Auction for DeafCAN! and hope to have **Jayson** show his gold medal, **Jason** talk about the PSD Boys' BB team, and Marlon (from Jamaica) tell about his recent passing of his U.S. citizenship interview/test! He will be the 14th individual that DeafCAN! assisted.





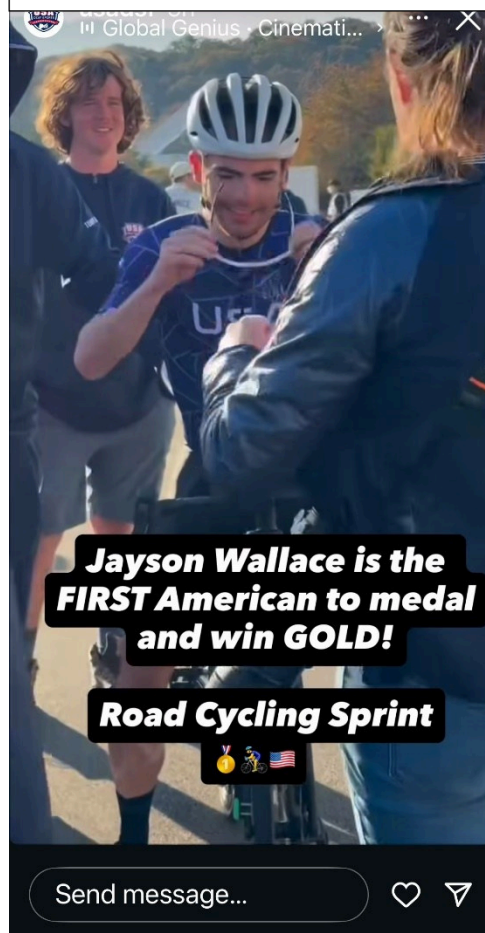

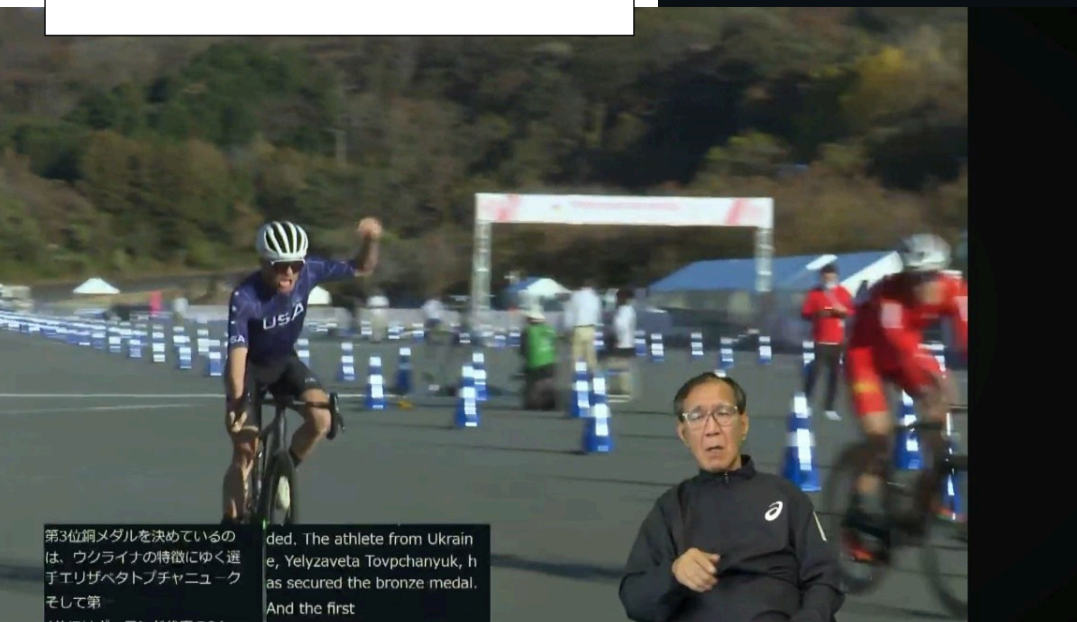
